As you are aware, we previously had an opportunity to perform an analysis of the Provider Defendants, including Mid-Atlantic Youth Services Corp. ("Mays"), PA Child Care, LLC ("PACC") and Western PA Child Care, LLC ("WPACC"). Our analysis was based primarily upon the documents listed in Appendix A to this letter and an interview of the Provider Defendants' outside accountant.

I understand that the Provider Defendants have agreed to settle the claims asserted against them by the Representative Plaintiffs, Class Counsel and the Individual Plaintiffs' Counsel in the below referenced matters.

The terms of the settlement in summary require the payment of \$2.5 million in specific or sooner payments between June 1, 2014 and December 21, 2015 as more particularly described below.

1. Subsequent to the Court's entry of the Preliminary Approval Order, but no later than June 1, 2014, the Provider Defendants will transfer \$600,000.00 (the "First Escrow Payment") into the Escrow Account.
2. No later than June 1, 2015, the Provider Defendants will transfer \$1,000,000.00 into the Escrow Account (the "Second Escrow Payment").
3. No later than December 21, 2015, the Provider Defendants will transfer \$900,000.00 into the Escrow Account (the "Third Escrow Payment," and collectively with the First Escrow Payment and Second Escrow Payment, the "Escrow Payments").

Based upon our analysis it is our opinion within a reasonable degree of professional certainty that the payment of \$2.5 million was fair and reasonable given the financial condition and equity value of the Provider Defendants after consideration of the significant third party debt obligations¹ totaling \$20,036,722 (comprised of a mortgage to PACC of \$7,616,653, a mortgage to WPACC of \$12,195,069 and a line of credit to Mays of \$225,000). Moreover, the payout over the time periods provided above are fair and reasonable given the Provider Defendants' financial obligations. Please let me know if you need anything further.
